WAOLA will provide as much notice as possible prior to cancelation, however, occasionally short notice cancellations are unavoidable.

A full refund will be issued when canceled 72 hours before your adventure departure time.

Any adventures canceled after 72 hours prior to your departure time, will be attempted to be resold. WAOLA reserves the right not to refund if the tour can not be resold.

Tours will not be canceled due to poor weather conditions other than relating to wind strength.

Terms of Use

Please arrive to departure dock at least 30 minutes prior to your departure in order to receive a safety briefing and sign release waiver if not previously signed and received electronically.

Please do not access the dock until told to so by the skipper.

All adventures are weather dependant and are subject to cancellation. WAOLA will give as much notice as possible, however occasionally short notice cancellations are unavoidable.

Trip duration for the Boat Adventure are approximated times.

WAOLA reserves the right to maintain advertised departure times, please make WAOLA aware if you are going to be late. Accommodation for late arrivals will result in a shortened adventure at full price of the full adventure. If there are others reserving the vessel that are not directly in your party, the right is reserved to leave at the advertised departure time and no refund will be issued.

WAOLA and its representatives are not responsible for any personal belongings at any time before/during/after the adventure.

Our Boat Adventures are currently not suited for individuals that may have back problems, disabilities, or are pregnant, as the docks can be precarious, there is a large/wide step onto the vessel, and while the loch is generally calm waters, that can not be guaranteed.
